

## Generations of Faith

Generations of Faith is an intergenerational faith formation experience that engages the whole parish in monthly faith formation journeys. Every person in the parish is invited to join us on the faith journey.

Generations of Faith covers the six pillars of the Catholic faith: Sacraments, Church Year Feasts and Seasons, Peace and Social Justice, Morality, Creed and Prayer on a six year cyclical approach. Each month we explore a topic from one of these six pillars. First we present the topic to the group, and then we break out into age specific groups for a more hands-on treatment of the topic. Each session includes a meal, a prayer experience and materials to take home to continue the experience throughout the month.
